## Summaries of Continuous Learning Plans from New Mexico School Districts and Charter Schools

#### **Background**

On March 26, 2020 through Executive Order 2020-012, Governor Lujan Grisham mandated the closure of all New Mexico schools for the duration of the 2019-2020 academic year. Previously, on March 13, 2020, a three-week closure was announced beginning March 16, 2020. Effectively, at the time of the publication of this report, New Mexico's 330,000 students have been out of school for over 21 days.

In lieu of direct classroom instruction, school districts and charter schools across New Mexico have been implementing new, innovative models of instruction for their students. Some immediately began implementing plans to engage with students and continue learning, while some are still working to establish plans for distance learning.

#### **Purpose**

This report was written with three purposes:

- 1. Provide a landscape analysis of how schools are continuing learning through the school closure period
- 2. Share information among district and school leaders, in hopes that ideas can be shared, and collaboration around best practices can take place statewide
- 3. Highlight the importance of strong communication from schools to their local communities

#### What's included in this report?

This report includes information that was publicly available via school and district websites and social media pages. This report does not include analysis of official "Continuous Learning Plans" submitted to the Public Education Department, unless the plan was posted online, or was shared during an embargoed review period for district and charter school leaders.
