





nearly 1 In 3 parents say they have not had a one on one meeting with their child's teacher or school since the beginning of the school year.




ACCESS TO LEARNING DEVICES

nearly 9 in 10 parents report they have access to a learning device for each child in their home.

94% of parents report that their child's school offered them a learning device.

nearly 9 in 10 parents report they have adequate internet in their home to support online learning.


only 61% of parents report they were offered internet service or a hot spot from their school or district.






over 75% of parents say their child is spending 100% of their time online, with no in person instruction


TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT IS A STRUGGLE

My child can easily turn in their completed assignments.






PARENT AND TEACHER COMMUNICATION

parents say their child learns most when their teachers:





47% of parents say their child has learned little or nothing, while 53% say their child has learned some or a lot




